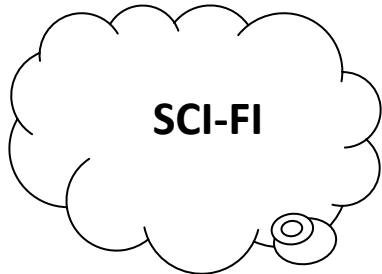
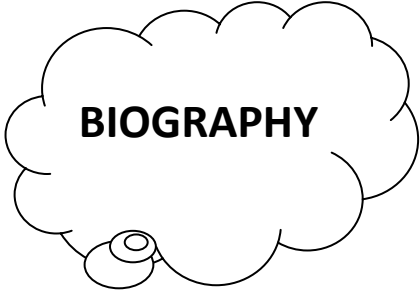
- **Appreciate Nature** - Go for long walks in a park or garden with your family and friends. Adopt / Grow a plant.

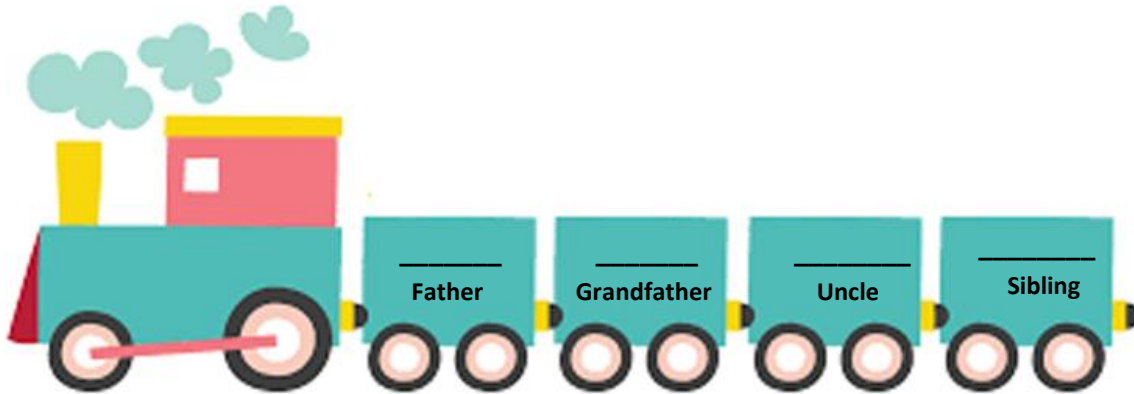
