Math and EVS Experiential Learning

At SVIS, we believe in creating knowledge through an experience. These Math and EVS Experiential Learning classes are conducted every alternate week to give hands on experience to the children through learning by doing, observation and reflecting on their experiences. During EVS Experiential learning class, the children sowed the coriander seeds and recorded the life stages of a plant through observation. An activity, 'Scavenger Hunt' was conducted during Math Experiential Learning class. The children learnt about the Indian currency and its denominations through an engaging game wherein they searched for the hidden denominations and learnt to transact in day to day life.



General Awareness

We at Sri VIS provide a platform for all knowledge enthusiasts to get together and deliberate on different topics in General Awareness Classes through on going General Awareness Program (Digital) by Greycaps. It is a place where students Share interests, discuss various subjects, or simply, read something of knowledge value. Exploring places, Virtual Tours, Monthly quizzes, fun quizzes, etc break the monotony of our future leaders through positive engagement and thinking beyond the box.



Read Aloud Sessions

Reading not only imparts knowledge but sparks child's imagination and stimulates curiosity. The young learners at SVIS are continuously engaged and encouraged to read through read aloud sessions, storytelling, gripping Short Read cards, picture reading and sharing book reviews. Reading for pleasure is emphasised for child's social, cognitive, mental development and wellbeing.

PPT

Teaching using interactive PPT has made the learning interesting for students. It has not only increased students focus but also led to better grasp of concepts with greater visual impact

Art Integrated Project

We engaged the young minds of our students through an art integrated project based on Sikkim state. The theme Cultural Potpourri required them to work in groups and this developed their collaborative skills and helped them delegate roles and responsibilities, share diverse perspectives and pool knowledge and skills.



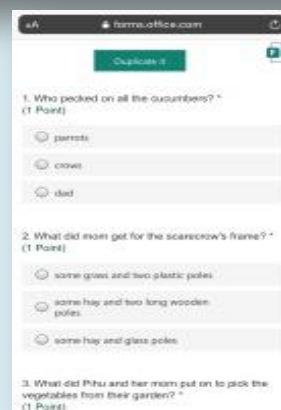
Language Activities

This period has certainly put us in a fix where we can't move beyond the vicinity of the house. However, this is the perfect time for students to polish and pick new hobbies and interests to hone their linguistic skills. Students are getting the opportunity to show their talent through activities like Show and Tell, Calligraphy, sharing new vocabulary words, creative writing, reading activities etc.



Worksheets

To keep the students more engaged and interested, worksheets through Microsoft Forms are being assigned to students regularly. They have proved to be an effective tool to encourage them and recapitulate the concept and also to monitor the progress of their own learning.



Circle Time

Our curriculum is focused to develop the best in each and every child. We encourage our students to interact with each other during Circle Time. Activities like talking about their best qualities, flipped learning sessions, Value of Reading, Reading Comprehension etc benefit their growth and social development. They learn that each child is a valued member of the group.

Podcasts

Content related podcasts are being sent after the delivery of the concept to enable the child to recall and go through the topics as and when required. Students can listen to it at their convenient time. It has also encouraged students deliver their own videos explaining the concepts learnt and improved upon their listening skills.

Interschool Events

The young, ignited minds of our society are our greatest assets. We, at SVIS, cherish these youngsters and encourage them to explore their true potential by awakening their passions and cultivating their talents. The students of the school are getting opportunity to participate virtually in various interschool competitions, where they not only prove their mettle but also present tough competition for the other participant.



Remedial Classes

The remedial classes are scheduled twice every week. These classes are provided to few students to help them get a grasp in the concepts and lessons in which they are not able to cope as well as it acts beneficiary for the students as they are able to revise various lessons and concepts taught to them in their regular classes. The focus of the language remedial class is to enhance their LSRW skills. Activity based Math teaching caters to visual understanding of the concepts. The key element in remedial classes is oral discussion, so that all the students are able to have an interactive knowledgeable session with the teacher.

Online Special Classes for CWSN

We modify the syllabus according to the needs of the children. Regular general instructions are given so that they are able to focus and build up interest. Our focus is always on Multi-Sensory Approach. We emphasize on how to take precautionary methods during the pandemic and also encourage the children to indulge themselves in various indoor activities like games or small household chores. Use of puppet for storytelling or introduction of topic is done to enhance the imagination and creativity of the children. Follow up with the parents on weekly basis for follow up of the activities/ task.

Considering IEP, we take care of all the needs. For example, for hyperactive child with sensory issues, we guide parents to arrange a balancing ball to satisfy his needs.

We introduce all the concepts in play way method that children really enjoy and parents enhance the learning by providing support to the teachers.

Class Assembly

Class assembly provides platform for students to showcase their talent and boost their confidence. We are conducting it on weekly basis comprising of varied themes like - Friendship, Happiness, Health is Wealth, Reading etc. Students celebrate the theme with activities like creative thought, news, book review, speech, fun facts, poem, song and dance. It plays an important role in holistic development of children.



International School Awards (ISA)

International School Awards (ISA) is a programme that recognises and celebrates exemplary practices of internationalism in schools. The on-going ISA project this year is - Currency - The World in my pocket, which involves the comparative study of currencies of Wales, France and India. Collection of resources was done by children through real/fake samples, ppts, videos and stories. In addition to this, they explored the interesting facts about these currencies in regards to symbol, denominations, famous personality and issuing authority.



Use of Math and Science Kits

Children in Grade 2 are in concrete operational stage of Cognitive development which strongly recommends use of Maths and Science kits as it not only enables children acquire the concept effectively but also get hands-on experience and practical knowledge of the concept. We are using diverse resources which are easily available at home like counters, place value cards and kidney beans for Mathematics and kitchen ingredients, plants and card models in Environmental Studies.



Specialized Comprehensive and Continuous Evaluation

To evaluate students for their better performance, Comprehensive and Continuous Evaluation through various assessment activities are being conducted by teachers on regular basis like quiz time, Microsoft forms and taking short recaps every day. This has helped improving students' performance by identifying their learning difficulties at regular time intervals.

Life Skills

Life Skills Classes are essentially an exercise in helping children develop positive minds cultivate positive personalities, sound judgement and good habits for long-term stability, wellness, and success. Story-telling, interactions, biographies, simple pictorial stories are used to explain values, principles and help learners imbibe them.
